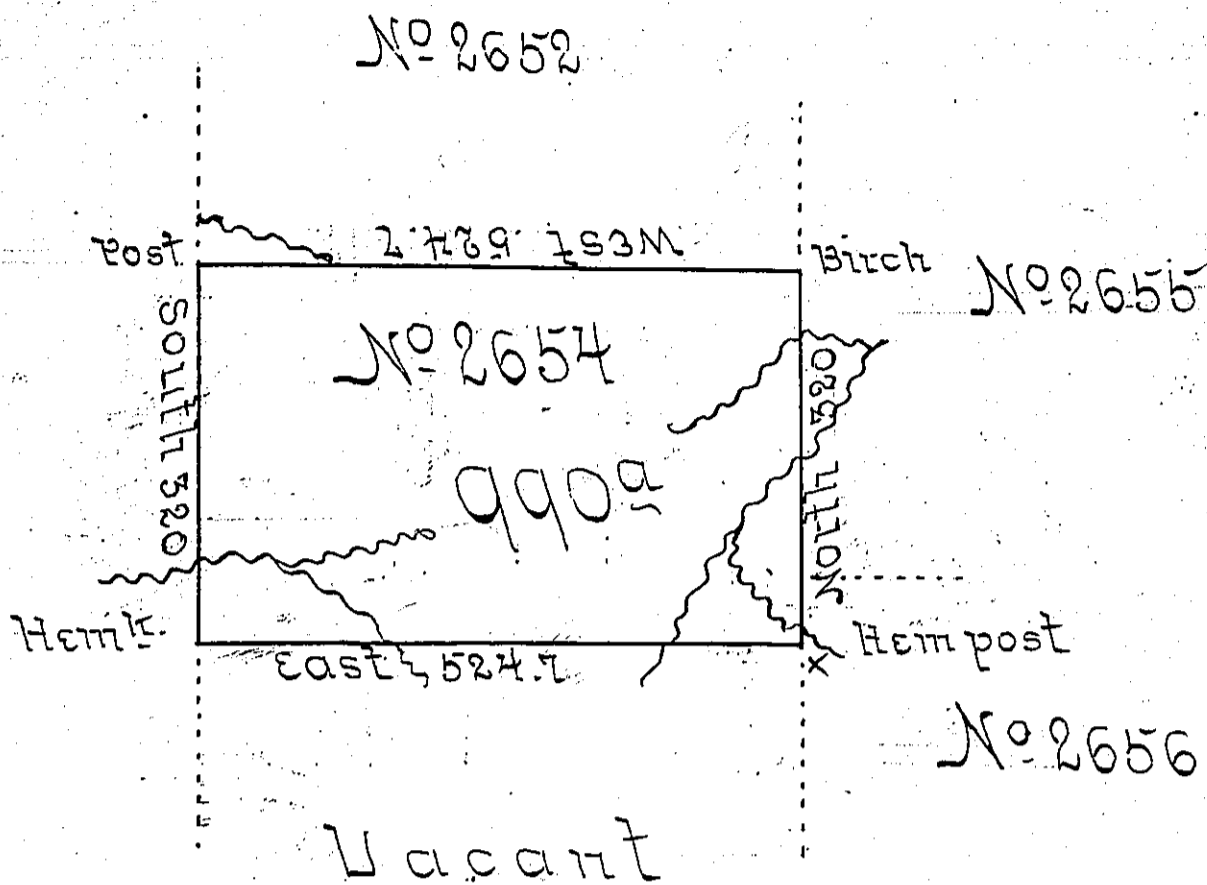


John Brodhead's District



Surveyed the above described Tract of Land on the 28th day of the 9th Mo. 1793 for Wilhem Willink, Nicholas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Wollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmel-pinnick, of Amsterdam in pursuance of their Warrant No 2654 dated December 12th 1792. Situate upon the westerly waters of Pine Creek & Easterly ~~waters~~ Waters of Kettle Creek, adjoining their other Lands & John Brodheads District &c as above described - Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety Acres & the Allowance of six P Cent -
