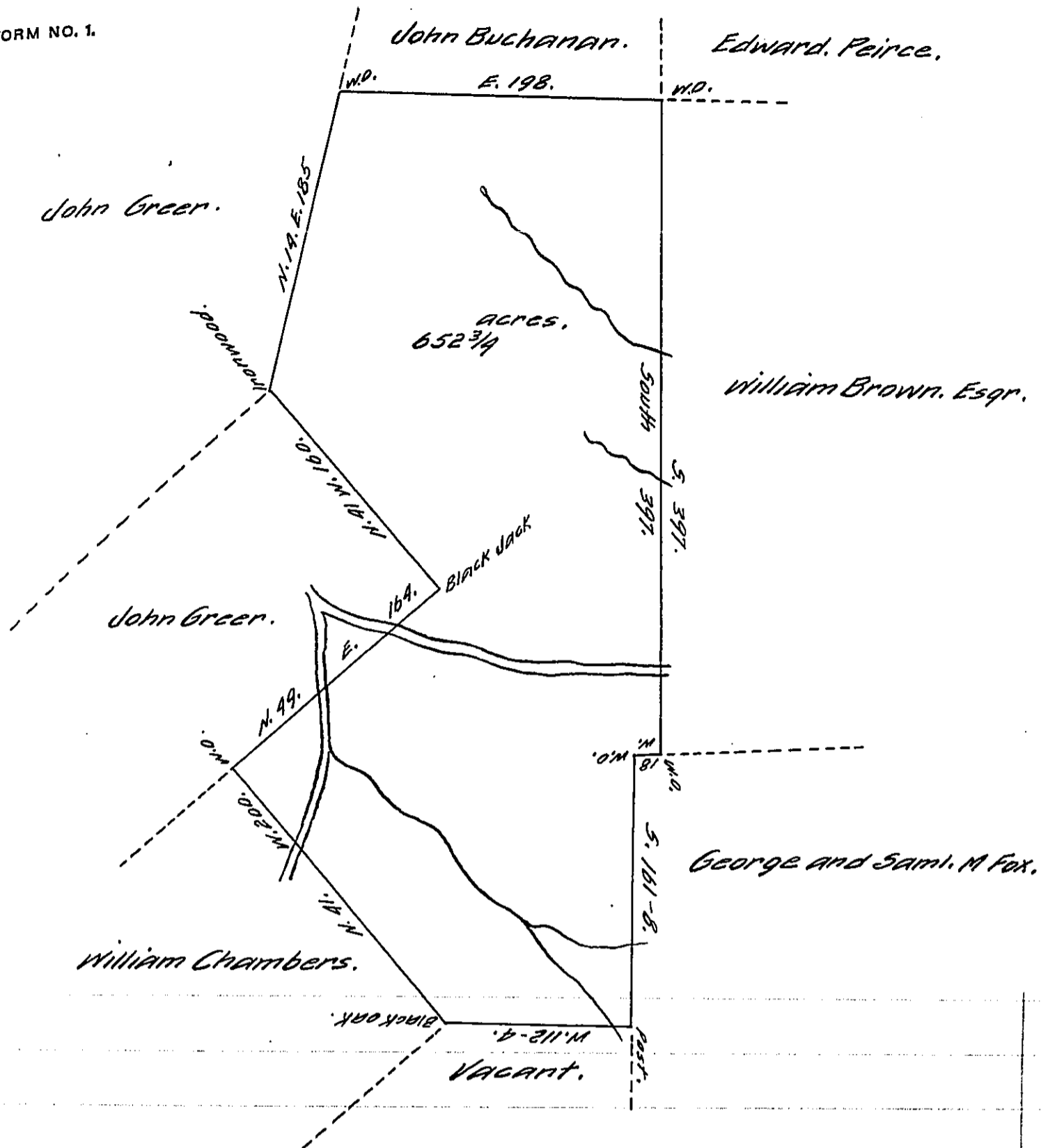

Ct & situated and lying on Lick Creek a branch of Tobys Creek and adjoining lands of George and Samuel M. Fox. William Brown Edward Peirce John Buchanan William Chambers and his other lands in Northumberland by warrant dated the 17th day of May 1785 Number 514.
