



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 10<sup>o</sup> & Allowance of 6 Per Cent for Roads &<sup>o</sup> Being part of a larger Tract of 52<sup>o</sup> & 80 Perches and Allowance of Land, which was Originally Surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 5<sup>th</sup> Mo. 1793. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D<sup>o</sup> 1793. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D<sup>o</sup> 1814. And now at the request of the present owner George Williams the above has been returned for Confirmation the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August A<sup>o</sup> D<sup>o</sup> 1817.
