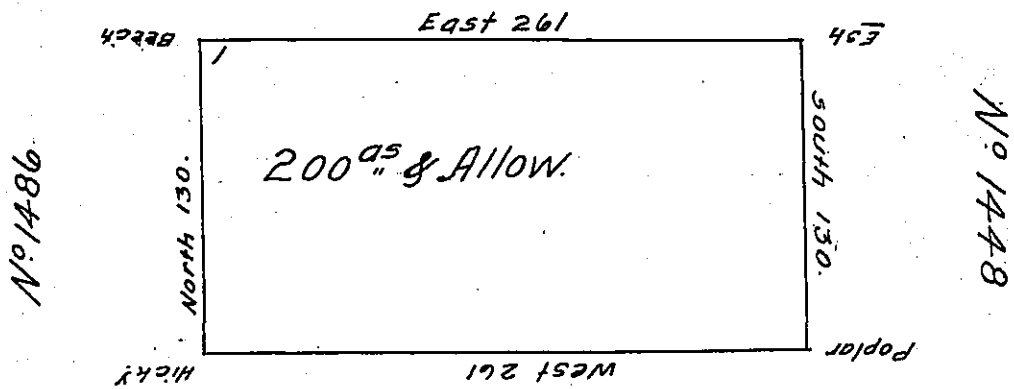

No MCCC LXI. Situate in Dist<sup>t</sup> No 7 on the West side of Alleg<sup>y</sup> River, in the County of Westmorland.
