



Whereas There was formerly a warrant granted by ye Late Commiss^{rs}. unto John Gray bearing date ye 22^d of ye 12th. mo. 1685/6 to Resurvey a tract of Land on ye west side of Neshamanyes Creek ye which belonged to Dunk Williams and Francis Walker Joyntly and held ffor ye quantity of ffour hundred & ffifty acres the over-plus of which was granted by ye said warrant. unto John Gray, Since which it hath pleased ye Proprietary to Sell ye said overplus unto ye said John Gray and thereupon Lent his possitive order. Directed unto us bearing date ye 4th of ye 10th. Mo. 1687. Willing and Requireing us to putt ye said John Gray into quiett possession of ye same. These are Therefore in ye Proprietary's name to will and Require Thee fforthwith to make an Executed Returne of ye Aforesaid warrant. bearing Date ye 22 of ye 12th. mo. 1685/6 unto ye Secretarys office notwithstanding a Letter bearing date ye 23^d of ye 12th. mo. 1685/6 Directed unto Thomas fairman fforbiding him to Execute ye Same. Given at Philadelphia ye Sixth day of ye Second 1688.
