JOEL BAILEY PAPERS, 1794-1854

Papers of Joel Bailey (b. 1789, d. 1845) of Penn's Manor, Bucks County, a blacksmith and contractor on public works. He was 1st lieutenant of Capt. R. M. Crain's Company in the War of 1812. For many years subsequent he was brigade inspector and a prominent military officer. He was keeper of the state arsenal at Harrisburg and burgess of the borough in 1832. He also served several terms as member of Council.
