(80th Regt.), during the Civil War. He was mustered in
on Oct. 29, 1861, as 1st Sgt. at Camp Greble, Penna. at
the age of 28. His residence was Clinton Co., Penna.
He was promoted to 1st Lt. June 25, 1863, and killed in
action April 2, 1865, at Selma, Alabama.
