Special attention is called to the twelve elaborate ornamentations facing folios 3-6-8-36-42-50-58-59-87-89-106-121. ZIONITISCHER WEYRAUCHO HUGEL ODER MYRRHEN BERG. 12 mo., preface 10 p., text 792 pp. This hymn book was set by the Ephrata Brethren and printed in the year 1739, on the newly acquired press of Christopher Saurer at Germantown, and was the first American book in German Type.
