Joshua Gilpin (1765-1840) and Thomas Gilpin, Jr. (1776-1853), were the sons of Thomas Gilpin, Sr. (1728-1778), who established the Gilpin mills on the Brandywine. The two sons operated as partners at both their commercial establishment in Philadelphia and at their mills on the Brandywine. In 1795 Joshua, leaving these enterprises in charge of Thomas, undertook a trip to the British Isles and the Continent, in the interest of investigating European practices in trade and industry. Despite the ingenuity, industry and financial resources of the Gilpins, they fell prey to a series of financial difficulties. In March of 1825 a serious fire devastated much of the paper mills. The following month Thomas, Jr., filed a petition in bankruptcy.

The great bulk of the papers of Joshua Gilpin and Thomas Gilpin, Jr., are to be found among the extensive Gilpin Papers (1727-1872, approx. 20,000 items) held by the Historical Society of Pennsylvania (See entry No. 238 in the Society's <u>Guide to the Manuscript Collections of the Historical Society of Pennsylvania</u> [2nd ed., Philadelphia, 1949]).

The Gilpin Papers at the Division of Public Records consist of two parts — the Journals and Notebooks of Joshua and miscellaneous business papers of Thomas, Jr.

The Journals and Notebooks of Joshua Gilpin long formed a part of the Division's collection of Diaries and Journals. During the summer of 1955 they were called to the attention of the Eleutherian Mills-Hagley

Foundation and microfilmed. In September Martha Simonetti, of the Division staff, discovered loose papers of Thomas Gilpin, Jr., in a group of Miscellaneous Boxes. It was then decided, on the grounds of convenience — and in the lack of contrary evidence concerning provenance — to withdraw the Journals and Notebooks of Joshua from the collection of Diaries and Journals and to combine them with the papers of Thomas, Jr., in a single Gilpin Collection. This has been done by Eugene E. Doll, who added the Minutes of a Committee of Stockholders of the Arbon Land and Coal Companies, an item which has every appearance of having once formed an integral part of the papers of Thomas Gilpin, Jr. The present inventory and new catalogue cards have been prepared by Doll.

Biographical material on Joshua and Thomas Gilpin, Jr., may be found in both Appleton's Cyclopaedia of American Biography (New York: 1888-1889) and John W. Jordan's Colonial Families of Philadelphia (New York: 1911). Relevant also are a memoir of Thomas Gilpin, Sr., written by one of the sons, and a paper, "Fairmount Dam and Water Works," both published in The Pennsylvania Magazine of History and Biography, (XLIX, 289-328, and XXXVII, 471-479). Other items in the Magazine may be conveniently located in its Index: Volumes 1-75, edited by Doll (Philadelphia: 1954). Interesting comments on the Gilpins and their mills on the Brandywine are to be found in the diary (1825-1828) of W. P. Brobson, an item also held by the Division of Public Records.

I. Journals and Notebooks of Joshua Gilpin. 1790-1809, 1830-1833. 62 small volumes and 1 envelope.

These are chiefly a record of travels in Great Britain, Ireland, and Continental Europe, with special attention to industrial developments, internal improvements, mechanical devices, and public institutions. The individual notebooks deal with an early normal school for women;

Caracas, Venezuela; vines and wines of Bordeaux; paper; canals; observations on Continental Europe; a ledger (1830-1833); and an inventory of books, silver and linens.

The journals are arranged in a chronological sequence, with some gaps. Exact chronology is at times difficult to determine, as certain volumes include sections written from back to front, while the narrative is frequently interrupted by extended observations on special subjects. The indication of dates is not always precise, and not infrequently the year, month, or day is omitted altogether. In a number of instances tables of contents are to be found at the front of volumes.

These materials cover primarily the sojourn of Joshua Gilpin in England 1795-1801, a period during which he toured both Ireland and Continental Europe. Miscellaneous volumes include items pertaining to the United States and to Venezuela.)

There is also a transcript of a journal of a tour from Philadelphia to Pittsburgh and down the Ohio and Mississippi, 1809, published in The Pennsylvania Magazine of History and Biography: L, 64-78, 163-178, 380-382; LI, 172-190, 351-375; LII, 29-58. Associated is a negative photographic plate used in this printing.
