Have this day for the sum of Six pounds three shillings
and Nine pence to me in hand paid by Matthew
McCormell of the City of Philad^a bargained & sold to
the said McCormell all my right title & interest to a certain
Tract of Land in the Donation Land granted to the Pennsylv-
vania Line by said State, the quantity being two hundred
Acres and allowance as appears by the Survey & Draught
and N^o of the Lot drawn by me this day Viz N^o 1778 in
the First District - And do by these presents
for me my heirs & assigns bargain & sell convey and
make over to the said Mat^r McCormell his heirs
and assigns forever all my right title & interest to
said Land to his proper use & behoof - In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and Seal the 26th day of October 1786 -
