which I now have, or which ~~I may~~ heirs, executors, or administrators, may hereafter have
~~in the lands, my depreciation clothing, rations, rewards, bounties, gratuities, prize monies, and every other arrearage, claim and demand whatever due and owing to me from and by the United States or any particular state, and I do hereby for my self and my heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree, to and with the said Frederick & Molineux his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns that ~~my~~ heirs, executors, and administrators, will, at any time hereafter at the reasonable cost and charges of the said Frederick & Molineux heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, make, or cause to be made, any future conveyances and assurances in the law, necessary to be done, for the further transferring and confirming, all and singular the premises and claims hereby granted and assigned, or intended so to be. And do make constitute and appoint the said Frederick & Molineux my~~
true and lawful attorney; irrevocable to demand and receive sue for; and recover from the United States, or any particular State, or any person or persons, acting, by or under their or either of their authority, all and singular the premises, rights, claims, and emoluments herein above recited and sold, and now withheld and detained from me by the United States the State of Pennsylvania
~~as aforesaid~~ with power, also attorney or attorneys for that purpose, to make and substitute, and to do all lawful acts requisite for effecting the premises, hereby ratifying and confirming all that ~~my~~ said attorney or his substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.
