By these Presents, That I Michael Engle
late in the Artillery and Artificers commanded by
Colonel Flowers and also in the Regiment commanded by Col. Baldwin
in the service of the United States of America for value and the full consideration money to me —
in hand paid, at, and before the execution hereof by Frederick Molineux of Philadelphia
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE, and hereby Do grant, bargain, sell, transfer, con-
vey and confirm unto the said Frederick Molineux his heirs, executors,
administrators, and assigns for ever, all the right, title and interest whatsoever, in law and equity,
which I now have, or which my heirs, executors, or administrators, may hereafter have
to the lands, pay, depreciation, clothing, rations, rewards, bounties, gratuities, prize-money, and every
other arrearage, claim and demand whatever due and owing to me from and by the United States or
any particular state, and I do hereby for myself my heirs, executors and administrators cove-
nant and agree, to and with the said Frederick Molineux his heirs,
executors, administrators and assigns that my heirs, executors, and administrators, will, at any
time hereafter at the reasonable cost and charges of Frederick Molineux his
heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, make, or cause to be made, any future conveyances and assur-
ances in the law, necessary to be done, for the further transferring and confirming, all and singular the
premises and claims hereby granted and assigned, or intended so to be. And do make constitute and ap-
point Frederick Molineux of the City of Philadelphia my
true and lawful attorney; irrevocable to demand and receive sue for, and recover from the United States,
or any particular State, or any person or persons, acting, by or under their or either of their authority,
all and singular the premises, rights, claims, and emoluments herein above recited and sold, and now
withheld and detained from me by the United States or the State of Pennsylvania
with power, allo attorney or attorneys for me to appoint
requisite for effecting the premises, hereby ratify and confirming all that my said attorney or
his substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.
