giving and granting unto my said Attorney by these Presents my full
and whole Power, Strength and Authority in and about the Premisses to have
use and take all lawfull Ways and Means in my Name for the Recovery
thereof. And upon the Receipt of any ~~and Debts, Dues or Sums of Money~~ afore-
said, Acquittances, or other sufficient Discharges, for me and in my
Name to make, seal and deliver. And generally all and every other Act
and Acts, Thing and Things, Devise and Devises in the Law whatsoever
needfull and necessary to be done in and about the Premisses for the Re-
covery of ~~all or my Rich Debts or Sums of Money~~ aforesaid, for me
and in my Name to do, execute and perform as fully, largely and am-
