from June 10th 1779 to this Day, is hereby discharged from
the Service of the *United States*, in Pursuance of Orders received from
the Commander in Chief, bearing Date the third instant.

I farther certify that *Philip the 3rd* having
been *in the 1st Regt of the Legion* is intitled by the

Resolution of Congress, of the 13th February, 1779, to the Benefits
that have been, or hereafter shall be, granted by the said State to the
Noncommissioned Officers and Soldiers of the said Line.

November, 1783.
