In the Service of the United States of America, for a valuable and full Consideration to me in hand paid, at or before the Execution hereof, by James Bell of Northern Liberties, the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; HAVE and by these Presents, DO grant, bargain, sell, release, transfer, and assign unto him, his Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, for ever, all the Right, Title, Interest, Property, Claim and Demand, which I now have, or which I, my Heirs, Executors or Administrators, may at any Time hereafter have, of, in and singular the Lands, Pay, Cloathing, Rations, Rewards, Bounties, Gratuities, Prize-Money, and other Demands, due and owing, from the United States, or from any particular State, And I do hereby for myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators covenant and agree to and with the said James Bell, his Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, that I, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, shall and will, at any Time or Times hereafter, at the Request, Cost and Charges of him, his Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns, make, seal, execute and deliver, or cause or procure to be made, sealed, executed and delivered, all and every such reasonable Act and Deed, as may be necessary for Conveyance and Conveyances, Assurance and Assurances in the Law, for the perfect granting, conveying, releasing, transferring and assigning, all the Right, Title, Interest, Property, Claim and Demand, which I now have, or which I, my Heirs, Executors or Administrators, may at any time hereafter have, of, in and to, all and singular, the Lands and other the Premises, hereby granted and assigned unto him, his Heirs, Executors, Administrators and Assigns for ever, as by the said their Council learned in the Law, shall be reasonably advised, devised or required. And I do hereby make, constitute and appoint the said James Bell, my true and lawful Attorney, irrevocably, to ask, demand, recover and receive, of, and from the United States, or from any particular State, or from any Person or Persons, acting by, from, or under their, or either of their Authority, all and singular, the Lands, Pay, Arrearages of Pay, Cloathing, Rations, Rewards, Bounties, Gratuities, Prize-Money, and other Demands, due, owing, payable and belonging to me, or detained from me, by any Manner of Way or Means whatsoever, and upon Receipt thereof, to execute and deliver sufficient and requisite Receipts, Release and Acquittances for the same, and by good and sufficient Conveyances and Assurances in the said Lands, to the Purchaser or Purchasers thereof, his, her, or their Heirs and Assigns for ever. And also to sell, affix a name, and register in the Books of the Treasury of the United States, or of any particular State, for, or in Consequence of, my Services as aforesaid, with Power an Attorney or Attorneys under him, for the Purposes aforesaid, to make, and substitute, and to do all lawful Acts requisite for effecting the Premises, as fully and effectually to all Intents and Purposes, as I might or could do by being personally present, and it have been the same, hereby allowing, ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever, my last Attorney, or his Substitute, or Substitutes, shall or may do, or cause to be done therin, but subject to the Testimony whereof I have herein set my Hand and Seal, in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety One.
