ther sufficient Discharges for me and in my Name to make, sign, seal and
deliver; as also one or more Attorney, or Attorneys, under him to substitute or ap-
point, and again at his Pleasure to revoke, and further to do, perform and finish for
me and in my Name all and singular the Thing or Things, which shall or
may be necessary touching or concerning the Premises, as fully, thorouly and entire-
ly, as I the said

ing and confirming whatsoever my said Attorney shall Lawfully do, or cause to be
