KNOW YE, that I, John Knabpender of More Township
in the County of Northampton late a Soldier in the
America serves and also a Soldier in Capt Thaddeus Ranging
Company -
in the service of the United States of America, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Shillings
to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of
these Presents, by Jacob Swenck of Providence Township Northampton
County -

The receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained,
sold remised, release, quit-claimed, transferred and assigned and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell re-
mised, release, quit-claim, transfer, and assign to the said Jacob Swenck

and his
heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title, interest, property, claim and demand which I now have, and all
the right, title, interest, claim and demand which I, my heirs, executors or administrators, at any time hereaf-
ter may have to all the land which I am entitled to, and to all the lands which I or either of them may at any
time hereafter be entitled to from the Congress of the United States of America; And Also all the lands
which I am entitled to from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania - by virtue of

any Act or acts of the legislature of the said commonwealth, for my services as
in the army of the united states of America, for and
during the war with Great Britain and to every part and parcel thereof: - And all such pay, sum or sums of
money for arrearages of clothing, rations, rewards, gratuities, prize monies, commutations or otherwise how-
ever due to me for my services as aforesaid, for any supplies rendered to the United States or to any one
single state. To have, hold, receive, take, and enjoy the laid lands, monies and other the Premises hereby
granted and assigned unto, and to, and for the only proper use and behoof of the said Jacob Swenck

And I the said John Knabpender DO, for myself, my heirs, executors,
administrators and assigns, hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Jacob Swenck -

Jacob Swenck his heirs and assigns, that I the said
my heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall and will
at any time or times hereafter, at the request, cost and charges of the said Jacob Swenck -
his heirs or assigns, make seal and execute, or cause, or procure to be
made, sealed and executed, all and every such reasonable act and acts, thing and things, conveyance and
conveyances, assurance and assurances in the law whatsoever, for the perfect granting, conveying, remising,
releasing, transferring and assigning, all and singular the right, title, interest, claim and demand, which I the
said Jacob Swenck - have, or which I, the said

Jacob Swenck - my heirs, executors and administrators may at any
time hereafter have, or, in and to the lands, pay, monies, and other the premises hereby granted and assigned,
and of me and to every part and parcel therof, unto the said Jacob Swenck -

Jacob Swenck his heirs and assigns, to the only proper use and behoof of the said
his heirs and assigns for ever, as by his or
their counsel, learned in the law, shall be reasonably advised, devised, or required: And I, the said

John Knabpender my true and lawful attorney irrevocably, to ask, demand,
solicit, and obtain in my name or otherwise, but for the sole use and behoof of the said Jacob Swenck
and from the commonwealth of Pennsylvania - respectively, a grant or grants, patent or
patents for the lands aforesaid, in his own name or names: And also to demand and receive all such pay,
sum or sums of money, for arrearages of clothing, rations, rewards, gratuities, prize monies, commutations
or otherwise however, due to me as aforesaid, and upon receipt thereof to pass any requisite receipt or
acknowledgment for the same; hereby ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever my said Attorney may
do respecting the same: And I, the said John Knabpender

for myself, my Executors, and Administrators, Do covenant, promise, and grant to and with the said
Jacob Swenck - his heirs, executors, Administrators and assigns, that I will
not revoke or annul the power of attorney herein contained, or do any act which shall impede the said

Jacob Swenck - in soliciting or obtaining a grant or grants, patent or
patents for the land aforesaid and receiving the pay, monies, or other the premises aforesaid. In Witness
