or other sufficient Discharges, for us, and in our Names to make, seal and deliver;
and generally all and every other Act and Acts, Thing and Things, Device
or Devices, in the Law whatsoever, needful and necessary to be done in and about
the Premises, for us, and in our Names to do, execute and perform, as fully,
largely and amply, to all Intents and Purposes, as I, myself might or could do, if
I were personally present, or as if the Matter required more special Authority than
