To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

**KNOW YE,**

Broadhead Colonel

That in consideration of the services rendered by Daniel

in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said Daniel Broad-  
head a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland,  
and in the 10<sup>th</sup> District of donation Lands Beginning at a Sugar Tree Running North  
by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 193 two hundred and forty one perches to an Ash Tree thence East by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 195  
three hundred and twenty five perches to an Ironwood Tree thence South by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 199 two  
hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar Tree thence West by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 197 three hundred  
and twenty five perches to the place of beginning Containing Five hundred Acres and  
allowance of Sixty feet for Roads &c. Numbered CXXVI.

with its appurtenances unto the said Daniel Broadhead his heirs and assigns forever:  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the

said Daniel Broadhead his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said  
Daniel Broadhead his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth  
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof The Honorable Charles Biddle  
Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused  
the state seal to be affixed the Ninth day of October in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and eighty six and of the commonwealth the Eleventh
