KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by Robert

in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said Robert Campbell

a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the county of Westmoreland

In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a Beech Tree the number one
corner and running East by Vacant Land two hundred and sixty one perches to a
Beech Tree, thence South by Lot No 2147 one hundred and thirty perches to a Sugar
Tree, thence West by Lot No 2145 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree
thence North by Lot No 2110 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of
beginning containing two hundred Acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads

the Number 11166 VI
with its appurtenances, unto the said Robert Campbell — his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the

said Robert Campbell — his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Robert Campbell — his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and

reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
