In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a beech tree the numbered corner
and running East by Vacant Land two hundred and fifty one perches to a sugar tree thence
South by lot No 291 one hundred and thirty perches to a birch tree thence West by lot 170
290 two hundred and fifty one perches to a beech tree thence North by lot No 109 one
hundred and forty perches to the place of beginning ~~containing~~ ^{one hundred acres}
and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Numbered M. E. C.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said
John Downey his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and
behalf of the said *John Downey his heirs and assigns forever*

free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle*
Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the State seal to be affixed the ^{twentieth} day of September in the year of our Lord one
