To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

**KNOW YE,**

*Dicks private*

That in consideration of the services rendered by

*Jacob Dicks*  
in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said Jacob Dicks  
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland, in the

*South District of the Colonization Lands Beginning at a Sugarree the numbered corner and running  
East by Sot. <sup>in 2002</sup> Two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugar, thence South by Vacant Land One hun-  
dred thirty perches to a Birch, thence West by Lot. <sup>in 2000</sup> Two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugarree  
thence North by lot. <sup>in 21119</sup> One hundred thirty perches to the place of Beginning containing ~~Four~~ <sup>Two</sup> ~~Four~~ <sup>Two</sup> ~~Four~~  
Acres allowance of six per cent for Roads <sup>in</sup> numbered MMJ*

**TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto  
the said *Jacob Dicks* *Jacob Dicks* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth  
clear of all charges. **IN WITNESS** whereof *The Honorable Charles Bulleid*

Esquire, the President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused  
the state seal to be affixed the *Twenty third* day of *February* <sup>in</sup> in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
