KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by George

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said George Harvey  
a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the county of Westmoreland

In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a post the numbered corner  
and running East by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 2080 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar  
Tree, thence South by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 2010 one hundred and thirty perches to a Beech Tree  
thence West by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 2078 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree  
thence North by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 193 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of begin-  
ning containing two hundred acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads for Numbered

with its appurtenances, unto the said George Harvey — his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the

said George Harvey — his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

George Harvey — his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
