To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by Joseph  
Binardo private in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto Joseph Binardo  
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland

*In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a Birch Tree the Numbered Corner and running East  
by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2011 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Spruce Tree thence South by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 1999 one hundred and thirty  
perches to a post, thence West by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2013 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar Wood Tree, thence North  
by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2077 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning containing Two Hundred Acres and  
allowance of Six<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads by <sup>the</sup> Numbered MMXII*

with its appurtenances unto the said Joseph Binardo his heirs and assigns forever :  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the  
said Joseph Binardo his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said  
Joseph Binardo his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth  
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof The Honorable Charles Biddle

Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused  
the late seal to be affixed the Seventh day of November in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the Eleventh
