*In the tenth District of Donation Lands Beginning at an Ironwood tree the numbered corner  
running East by vacant land two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech, thence South by Lot N°.  
116 One hundred & thirty perches to a Beech thence West by Lot N°. 2120 Two hundred and sixty one  
perches to an Elm, thence North by Lot N°. 2118 One hundred & thirty perches to the place of Beginning  
containing two hundred Acres ~~allowance of sufficient for Roads fence~~*

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said

*Sarah M. Murray her* heirs and assigns forever, *In trust nevertheless and to and for the  
use mentioned on the last Will and Testament aforesaid and to no other use nor purpose whatso  
ever -*

free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
