To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

**KNOW YE,**

*M. Cullock Private*

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Roger*

in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *Roger*

*M. Cullock* a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*  
In the Tenth district of donation Land Beginning at an Ash Tree the Numbered  
Corner and running East by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2069 two hundred and sixty one perches to an  
Ash Tree, thence South by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2099 one hundred and thirty perches to a Lynnwood  
Tree, thence West by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2067 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree,  
thence North by Lot N<sup>o</sup>. 2057 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning  
Containing Two Hundred Acres and allowance of six p[er]cent for Roads &c  
Numbered MMLXVIII.

with its appurtenances unto the said *Roger M. Cullock* — his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the  
said — *Roger M. Cullock* — his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
