

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

**KNOW YE,** That in consideration of the services rendered by *Eneas M<sup>o</sup> Hay Esquire late Colonel (deceased)* in the army of the *United States* there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *Mary Adams late Widow and Relict of the said Eneas M<sup>o</sup> Hay deceased*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland* in the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a Beech tree the numbered Corner and running East by Vacant land *Three hundred and twenty five perches* to a Beech thence South by lot *N<sup>o</sup> 181* two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugar tree thence West by lot *N<sup>o</sup> 182* three hundred and twenty five perches to a Beech tree thence South by lots *N<sup>o</sup> 199 1/2 and 199 5/8* two hundred and sixty one perches to the place of beginning containing *Seven hundred Acres* and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. *Numbered CLXXXI*

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Mary Adams her* heirs and assigns forever, *In trust nevertheless and to and for the use of herself and the children of the said Eneas M<sup>o</sup> Hay deceased* according to the laws of this Commonwealth

free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof
