To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE,

McCarthy Malros

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John W. McCarthy* in the late army of the United States,

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *John W. McCarthy* a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the county of Westmoreland in the tenth district of donation lands beginning at a sugar tree the numbered corner and running East by Lot N° 2056 two hundred and sixty one perches to an ash tree thence South by Lot N° 2058 one hundred and thirty perches to a beech tree thence West by Lot N° 2058 two hundred and sixty one perches to a beech tree, thence North by Lot N° 2050 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning containing Two hundred acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads & canals Numbered MMLVII

with its appurtenances, unto the said *John W. McCarthy* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *John W. McCarthy*

John W. McCarthy his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said *John W. McCarthy* his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges.
