KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by

~~Widow, and Administratrix~~ ~~and John Craig and David Sample Esq: Administrators of the Estate of~~ there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto ~~Jane Brookshanks late of~~ the said deceased ~~and~~ a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the county of Allegany,  
In the tenth district of Donation Lands Beginning at a Sugar tree the number red corner and running East by Lot No 196 three hundred and twenty five perches to a sugar tree thence South by lot No 197 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech tree thence West by Lot No 198 three hundred and twenty five perches to a sugar tree thence North by Lot No 192 two hundred and sixty one perches to the place of Beginning containing five hundred acres of land and allowance of six per cent for roads of Numbered 197 To have and to hold the said Tract of Land with the Appurtenances unto the said Jane Brookshanks John Craig and David Sample their Heirs and Assigns to the proper use and behoof of the said Jane Brookshanks John Craig and David Sample their Heirs and Assigns forever In trust nevertheless to and for the use of the Heirs of the said Samuel Miller deceased, and to no other use or purpose whatsoever free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the Pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *His Excellency Thomas Mifflin* Esquire, President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the State seal to be affixed the *twelfth* day of *September* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine and of the Commonwealth the *fourteenth*.
