To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

Malone private

That in consideration of the services rendered by Archibald

late in the army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *the said Archibald Malone*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland

In the tenth District of the Donation Lands Beginning at a Sugar tree the numbered corner and running East by Sol N. 2094 Two hundred and sixty one perches to an Ironwood tree thence South by Sol N. 2114 One hundred and thirty perches to a Cherrytree thence West by Sol N. 2096 Five hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech thence North by Sol N. 2086 One hundred and thirty perches to the place of Beginning containing Two hundred acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads five Yards wide

MMXCV

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Archibald Malone his *heirs and assigns forever, for the only proper use and behoof of the said Archibald Malone his Heirs and Assigns forever*

free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle* Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the *Twenty ninth day of March* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
