**KNOW YE,**

That in consideration of the services rendered by ~~Henry Overman~~

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said ~~Henry Overman~~  
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland

~~In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at an Iron Wood Tree the numberd  
Corner and running East by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 2115 two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugar Tree  
thence South by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 2123 one hundred and thirty perches to an Iron Wood Tree thence  
thence West by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 2113 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Cherry Tree thence  
North by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 2095 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning  
Containing Two hundred Acres and allowance of Six p Cent for Roads & Numbered~~  
**MMCXIV**

with its appurtenances unto the said ~~Henry Overman~~ his heirs and assigns forever:

HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the  
said ~~Henry Overman~~ his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said  
~~Henry Overman~~ his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth  
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof ~~The Honorable Charles Biddle~~  
Esquire, ~~the~~ President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused  
the state seal to be affixed the ~~Eighth~~ day of ~~December~~ in the year of our Lord one
