KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Joseph*

son Widow and Relict of the said Joseph Ferguson —

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland* in
the tenth district of the *Ionalcon Lands*. Beginning at a Beech tree the numbered corner and running
East by lot N^o. 2116 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a sugar tree thence South by lot N^o. 2117 One hun
red and thirty perches to an Ash, thence West by lot N^o. 2118 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a
sugar tree thence North by lot N^o. 2120 One hundred and thirty perches to the place of Beginninge
containing *Two hundred Acre and allowance of six per cent for Roads* in numbered *XLV* —

Ann O'Brian her Heirs and Assigns forever —

free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *His Excellency Benjamin Franklin* —
Esquire, — President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the state seal to be affixed the *Eleventh* — day of *April* — in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh* —
