To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

Spalding Drummer

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John Spalding*

in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *Stephen Loudon* *of* *signer* *of* *the*
said *John Spalding* *a* certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*
In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at an Ash Tree the Numbered Corner and
running East by Lot N^o. 2149 two hundred and Sixty one perches to a sugar Tree, thence South by
Lot N^o. 2000 one hundred and thirty perches to a sugar Tree, then west by Lot N^o. 2151 two hundred
and Sixty one perches to a Beech Tree, thence North by Lot N^o. 2149 one hundred & thirty perches
to the place of beginning containing Two Hundred Acres, allowance of Six p Cent for
Roads &c Numbered MMCL.

with its appurtenances unto the said *Stephen Loudon* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said *Stephen Loudon* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Stephen Loudon his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth

the state seal to be affixed the *Ninth* day of *November* in the year of our Lord one
