To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

*Murphy Shomy
Shomy private*

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Murphy*

in the army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto *the said Murphy Shomy*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland
in the tenth District of the Colonial Lands Beginning at a Sugar tree the numbered corner &
running East by Lot N^o. 2027 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech tree, thence South by Lot
N^o. 2044 One hundred and thirty perches to a Beech tree, thence West by Lot N^o. 2029 Two hundred & forty
one perches to a Beech tree, thence North Lot N^o. 96 One hundred and thirty perches to the place of be-
ginning containing Two hundred Acres and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c Numbered MMXXVIII

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said
Murphy Shomy his heirs and assigns forever, *to the only proper use and behoof of the said*
Murphy Shomy his Heirs and Assigns forever

free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *His Excellency Benjamin Franklin*
Esquire, President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the state seal to be affixed the *nineteenth* day of *May* in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
