To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

Winkler Private

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Frederick*

in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *Frederick Winkler*
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

*in the 10th District of Donation Land Beginning at a Beech and running North
by Lot N° 202 one hundred and thirty perches to a Beech thence East by Lot N° 2046 two hundred and
sixty one perches to an Iron fence South by Lot N° 2052 one hundred and thirty perches
to a Beech thence West by Lot N° 2044 two hundred and sixty one perches to the place
of beginning Containing Two Hundred Acres and allowance of six Cent for Roads &
numbered MMXLV.*

*with its appurtenances unto the said *Frederick Winkler* his heirs and assigns forever:*

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the

*said *Frederick Winkler* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said*

**Frederick Winkler* his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and*

*reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle**

*the state seal to be affixed the *Ninth* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one*
