



By Virtue of an Order Issued in behalf of Joseph Richardson bearing date the 20th: day of December Anno: Domini: 1760 The above described Tract of Land was Survey'd unto Isaac Williams in right of the said Joseph Richardson situate in Gosport Township in the County of Chester Beginning at a Spanish Oak in a line of the Land of the said Isaac Williams Thence North 65th East four perches & an half to a Black Oak Corner of John Griffith's Land Thence by the same South 27th East 121th perches to a corner of the Land late of John Ashbridge Deceased Thence by the same South 65th West 9th perches to a fallen Chestnut Thence by the Land of the said Isaac Williams North 25th West 121th perches to the place of Beginning Containing Four Acres & one hundred & twenty nine perches Beside the allowance of Six p Cent
