



Situate in Paradise Township, York County; & containing as above set forth 320.72 ps. & allowance of Land. It being a part of a larger tract of 79 1/2 a. of Land Surveyed by Charles Lukins, late D.S. on the 4th. day of May 1774 (in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 15th. of March 1753 granted to James Benezet;) and divided off from the sd. larger tract at the same time. And now, after having been carefully examined, corrected and calculated, it is at the request of the present owner, John Wiest, returned for Confirmation the 26th. day of August Anno Domini 1809.
