



A Draught of a Tract of Land called \_\_\_\_\_ situate on the Waters of Lahawanack Creek northward of a large ridge of hills about seven miles on a course near North from a certain large Indian Cabbin standing on the West Bank of a large Branch of Lahawanack about four miles from the place called Copans Meadows in the County of Northumberland containing Three hundred and one acres and three quarters of an acre besides the usual allowance of 6 P.Ct. for Roads &c<sup>ts</sup>.

Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1774 for George Fullerton in pursuance of a warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1774.
