



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land belonging to James White Situate on the waters of Charters Creek called 'Stony Lick' containing 388 acres 2 rods and 20 pns. Survey'd March 24th 1785. In Pursuance of the Herunto Attest Certificate Viz.

We the Commissioners for Adjusting Claims to Unpatented Lands in the County of Monongalia, ^{of Virginia & Ohio} do hereby certify that James White is Entitled to 400 acres of Land in the County of Upshogania on the Waters of Charters Creek to include his actual settlement made in the year 1748. Also a right in preemption to one thousand acres Adjoining thereto. Given under our hands at Coxes Fort the twenty fifth Day of February 1780 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
