



Surveyed the above described tract of land the twenty sixth day of August 1836 for Samuel Graham by Virtus of his Order of Recovery dated 29th June 1835.

Warrant dated 22nd Dec. 1814, Surveyed 23 Jan. 1818, Recovered as above dated, Containing two hundred acres & fifty five perches with the allowance of six per cent &c. Situated in Chapman Township, Lycoming County on the North Side of the West Branch Susquehanna River about two miles below Young Wominstown & bounded as above.

Note:- there are about three acres of cleared land & a log house on the part abt. surveyed. Improvement began 1 Aug. 1792.

Note:- also the part marked it interferes with a survey to J. Armstrong and A. W. Parsons on Warrant dated 5 Dec. 1834.
