



Note the real Circumstance of this survey is thus, Richd. Hall & Jno. Foshee is both deceased. a considerable time ago. But some years previous to their decease I Survey'd the Land in the names and form as above represented, then as an assistant to A. McClean and Mr. Hall not knowing of the location right of Jacob Speer's Adjoining, intended Covering the greater part of that, with his Warrant but finding himself disappointed, Conditioned with John Foshee to include his 192 1/2 a. in the survey together with his remaining 99 1/4 a. in order to fill his Warrant I heard Both parties consent to the agreement & take the whole in one patent, sd Hall to convey Foshee's part to him &c.
