



Situate in Hopewell Township York County containing as above set forth fifty four acres, sixty six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 197<sup>ac</sup> 56<sup>pc</sup> & all originally surveyed by William Matthews late D. S. on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month of Decr 1760, in pursuance of two warrants granted to Archibald Purdy, one for 50<sup>ac</sup> 45<sup>pc</sup> dated the 14<sup>th</sup> day of June 1765, the other for 50<sup>ac</sup> dated as last mentioned. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1821 for Christian Souder the present owner of said part, at whose request the same is returned for confirmation
