At the Request of Isaac Norris that we would grant him to take up the proportion of Liberty Land appurtenant to the original purchase of one Thousand acres made of the late Proprietor by Alexander Parker. The right to which said Liberty Land being now vested in the sd Isaac Norris.

These are therefore to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto the said Isaac Norris in right of the aforesaid purchase, within the Liberties of Philadelphia the said proportion of land that has not been heretofore surveyed nor is lawfully claimed by any other person and make Return thereof into the Secretarys office in order for a further confirmation. Given under our Lands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 3^d day of October Anno Domini 1728.
