



A Draught of a Piece of Land, situate in Shrewsbury Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 40<sup>ac</sup> 100<sup>ps</sup> and allowances. Part of 57<sup>ac</sup> 54<sup>ps</sup> & allowances &c. which was originally surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Frey for 30<sup>ac</sup> dated the 15<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1787, directed to be surveyed in three pieces &c. Surveyed and returned on the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1807 by Jacob Spangler &c. Now on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November A. D. 1839, examined the above and found to be correct and being requested to make Return thereof for John Craumer the present owner who wishes to patent the same &c.
