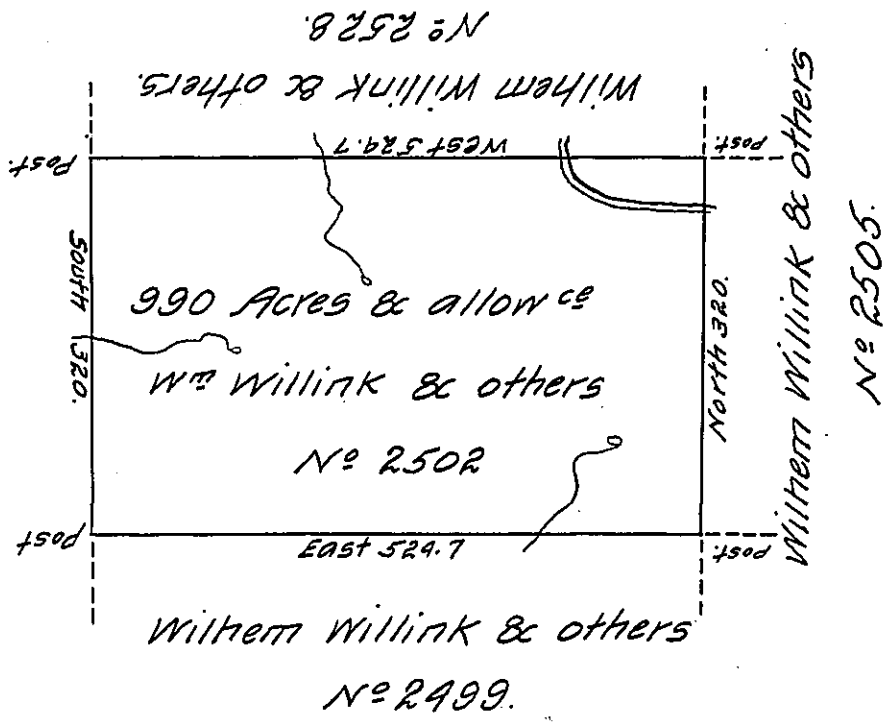

Situate in District N^o 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River adjoining Wilhem Willink, and others N^o 2499; by virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam, N^o 2502; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
