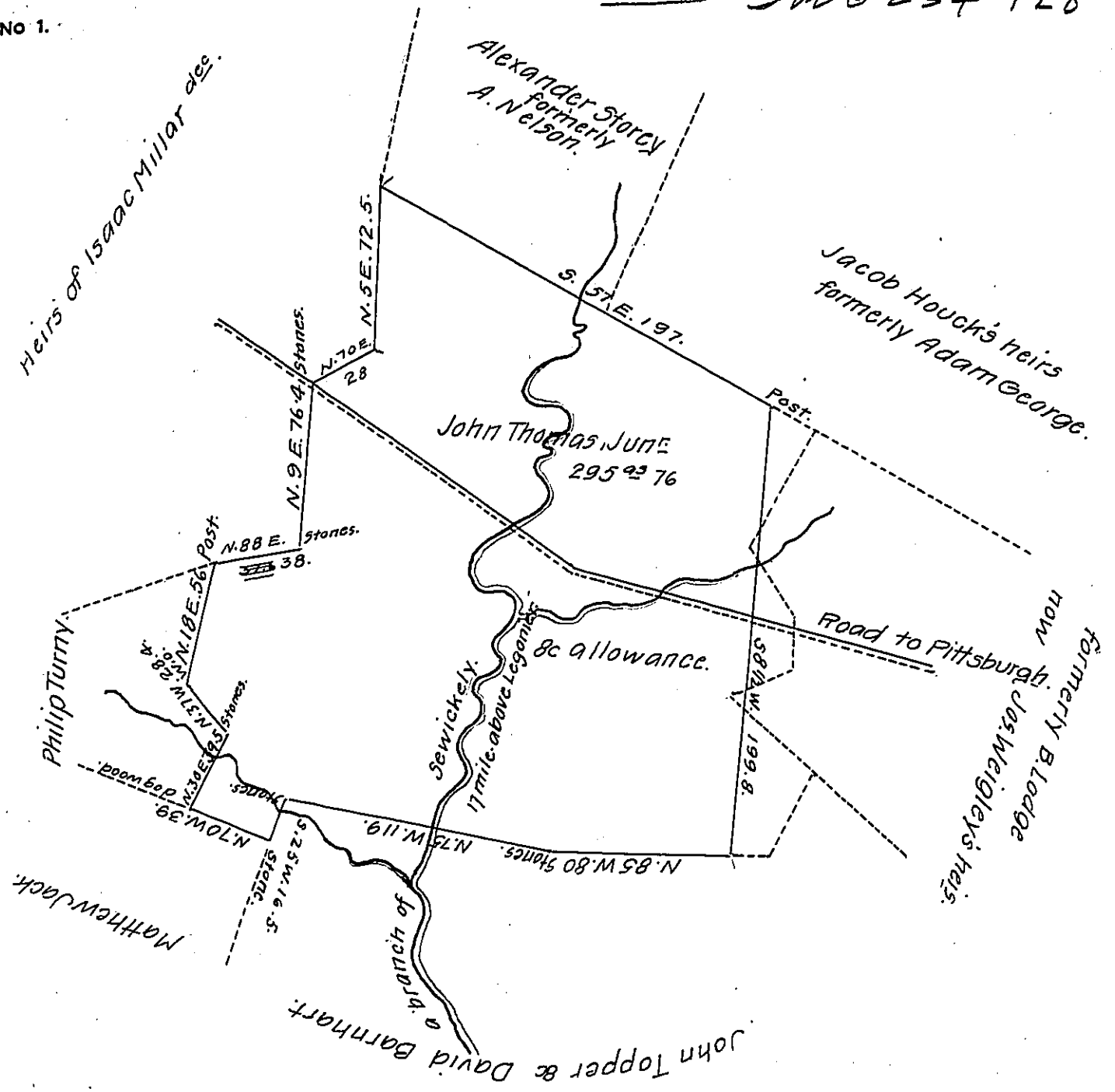


FORM No 1.



In pursuance of an Application granted to John Thomas, Jr. N. 1844 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> of April 1769 surveyed the above described tract of Land on the 6<sup>th</sup> of February 1829 containing two hundred and ninety five acres seventy six perches and the allowance proportioned at six per Cent. for roads &c. situate on a small branch of the Sewickley's 17 mile above Ligonier in in part Hempfield and part Unity Township Westmoreland County Pa.
