



Resurveyed the 25<sup>th</sup>. day of the 1<sup>st</sup>. month 170<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> by virtue of a warrant from the Com<sup>rs</sup>. of Property dated the 21<sup>st</sup>. of the 11<sup>th</sup>. month 1701 a Tract laid out to Thomas ffairman Containing 636<sup>A</sup>. 1<sup>R</sup>. 16<sup>P</sup>. lying in Bensalem Township. Beginning at a white oak by a Rock upon the bank of Neshameneh Creek being Bowen's Corner. Thence by the said Bowen's line W. 18 deg<sup>rs</sup>. S. 160 perches to a Corner marked white oak, Then by Jonas Skeen's line S. W. 85 per. to a Post in Tobias Dymock's line. Then by the same N. N. W. 418 per. to a Post at Joseph Growdon's great Tract, Then by the said Tract E. N. E. 339 per. to a white oak fallen at Samuel Allen's Corner. Then by the said Allen's land S. 9 deg<sup>rs</sup>. W. 270 perches to a spanish oak. Then S. E. by E. 165 per. to a Corner marked Maple by the said Creek. Then down the several Courses thereof to the place of beginning.
