



By virtue of Warnt. from the Proprietaries Comrs. to me directed bearing date the 14th / 27th / mo. 1703 to Resurvey unto Jasper Lawrence son & heir of Willm. Lawrence deceased a tract of land in Warminster in Bucks County laid out for 450 acres, Resurveyed the sd. tract beginning at a black oak sapling at John Hart's Corner. Thence North West by sd. John Hart, George Randal, Joseph Tod, Proprietaries land, and Jo. Jones one thousand and eighty four perches, to a Gum tree. Then by Incognita North East. Sixty eight perches to a Post. Then South East by Benjamin Hurley, James Boyden, Valentine Huddlestone, David Lloyd, George Willard & John Burden one thousand & Eighty four perches to a black oak. Then by Proprietaries land South West Sixty eight perches to the place of beginning. Containeing four hundred &

Sixty acres and an halfe and thirty ^{two} perches, Resurveyed the 18th / 5th / mo. 1704.

This is laid down by a scale of 200 in an Inch.
