ed unto him Six hundred Acres of Land in the County of
Bucks where not already taken up according to the Method
of Townships appointed by the Governr, he Seating and
Improveing h_e same wthin twelve Month from the Date
of Survey & Make returne thereof to the Secretary's
office given at Philadelphia 22th 5m 85
