One Lot of Land containing in breadth fifty One foot & in length on the north Side thereof three hundred & Twenty foot & on the South Side thereof three hundred & Six foot. bounded northward wth a vacant lot. to the Eastward wth the Second Street from Schoolkil to the Southward wth Tho Lloyds Lot, to the Westward wth School Kill front Street, One other lot of Land situate in Philadelphia afores^d cont^d in length on the North side thereof three hundred thirteen foot on the South side two hund. ninety Seven foot in breadth forty foot bound northward wth a lot of John Michaels Jones on the South wth a vacant lot westward wth schoolkil front Street & on the Eastward with the Second Street from Schoolkil - One other peice or parcel of Land cont^d Seven acres near the Town of Philadelphia beginning at a corner post near Lancelot Lloyds & thence East by a Line of trees forty three perches thence North Eighteen degrees westerly by a Line of trees thirty five & a half perches then North-erly Seventy two degrees westerly by Vine Street thirty Seven perches thence North Eight degrees Easterly Easterly by a Line of trees twenty three perches to the place of beginning, ~~One other peice or parcel of Land~~ as also Two acres of Land near unto the Town of Philadelphia afores^d beginning at a corner post standing on the north side of a run thence East by a Line of Trees five hundred twenty Eight foot thence South Eighteen degrees westerly by the Second Street one hundred & Eighty foot thence west by a Line of Trees four hundred & Seventy Eight foot thence North Eighteen degrees East-erly by the front Street one hundred Seventy one foot to the place of beginning. also one other Lot cont^d One hundred & two foot front & running back to the Second Street being part of the Estate of Sarah Eckley deceased
